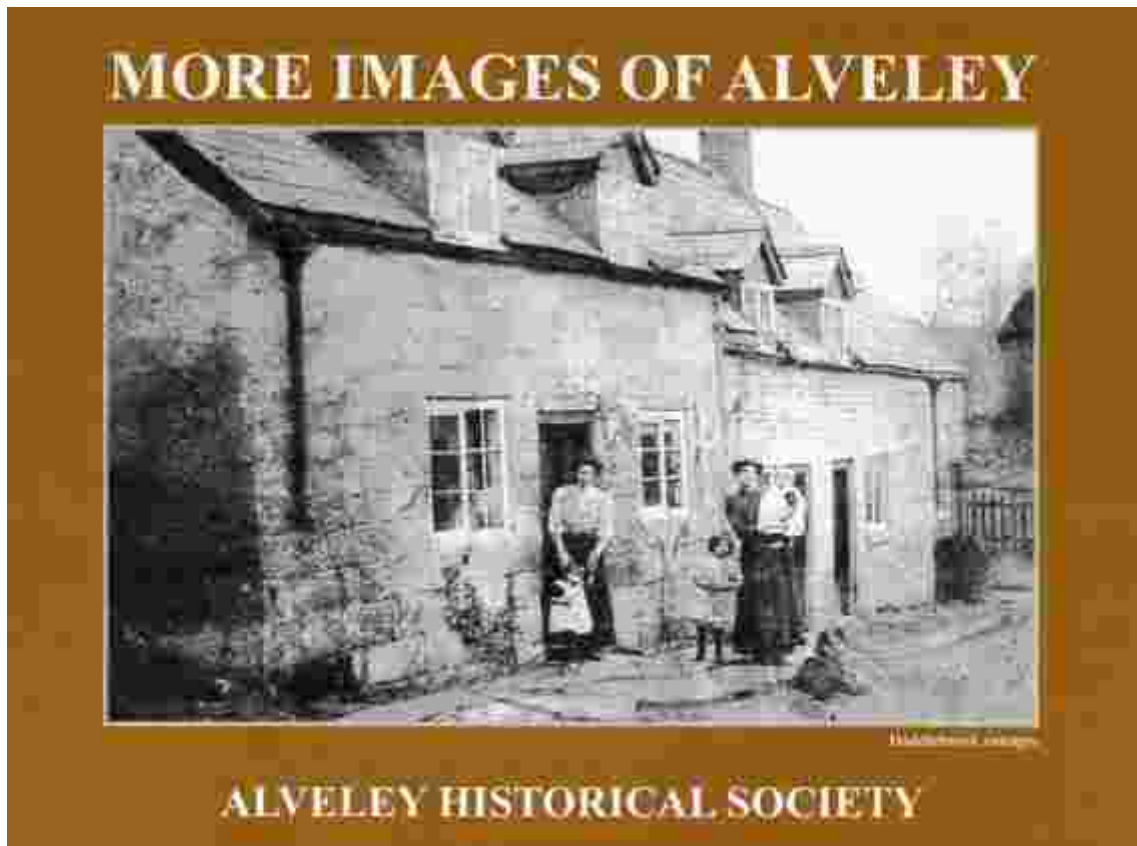


MORE IMAGES OF ALVELEY
